## Lego 'Fire Walk' takes place at Calne School

**Kingsbury Green Academy staged a Lego 'fire walk' yesterday (17/03/26) in aid of new outdoor furniture for the school.**

Members of staff braved the painful walk in bare feet across Lego bricks, in place of hot coals, in front of a large audience of students.

The walk was four metres long and consisted of a chosen group of teachers and staff stepping on a red carpet, laid out in front of them, full of Lego.



Hayley Illman, Co-Head of Student Engagement who helped with the idea, said: "Our Student Leadership Team is raising money for new benches and table seating for the school field and came up with this rather novel idea.

"It was a great, fun event which really got the school buzzing. Students were rallying around their favourite teachers."
